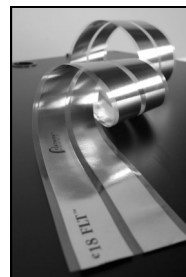

Microsoft Windows 7 hits the shelves this month!

It's almost here! Microsoft is due to release Windows 7 on October 22nd. So, what is all the hype about?

Microsoft's focus with Windows 7 was to create a more responsive and user-friendly system that is better suited for daily use. Things like improved taskbar features, enhanced search functions, and performance improvements, make Windows 7 a great operating system for home and business users alike.

What does this mean for businesses?

It is the Vista that works! Microsoft seems to have identified many of the issues that businesses were seeing with Vista and corrected them in Windows 7. They added an XP compatibility mode so Windows 7 can work with many of the older programs and is more compatible with older hardware too.

From a day to day standpoint, many Vista users have issues with network files, browsing folders, and slowness due to the format of Vista. It is not nearly as bloated as Vista either. It doesn't take as much room on the computer itself.

Now, with Windows 7, Microsoft has brought back the basics of earlier operating systems, so the user experience is a bit more like XP.

Security in Windows 7. Microsoft received a tremendous amount of flack for the security holes

in Windows XP. With Vista, they went over the top with security. Now, with Windows 7 they are doing things right. They found the middle ground they needed. Windows 7 is a more security conscious version of Windows XP but not quite as stringent as Vista, hounding users with warnings at every turn. Windows 7 isn't as intrusive.

What is the next move? We almost never upgrade clients immediately when a new version of Windows is released due to the requirements and changes necessary to adapt old computers to the new operating system. However, after testing Windows 7 for ourselves, technicians are seeing more positives than negatives at this point.

Chief concerns with Windows 7. The biggest concern with regard to Windows 7 is that many business applications may not be compatible right away. As with any new operating system, it will take time for software vendors to make compatibility changes to their packages. We will have to wait and see how far Windows 7 has truly come and how many programs will really work.

Microsoft is packaging copies and manufacturers are putting Windows 7 on new PCs this month. On October 22, you'll be able to get the final product! Test it out, see if it is a good fit for your company.

Pumpkin skills!

With Halloween just around the corner, we put together a few easy pumpkin carving tips to make this time honored tradition a success.

When selecting your pumpkin, be sure to choose an unbruised pumpkin about the size and shape of your design. Characteristics to look for, a pumpkin that is smooth, evenly colored so that your design will transfer clearly, and has a flat bottom so it sits upright.

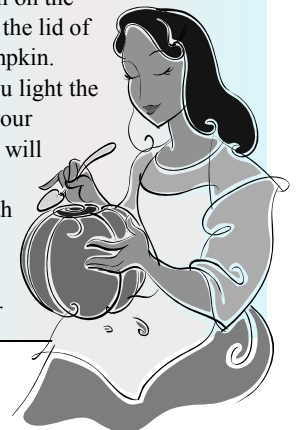
Once you have selected the perfect pumpkin, you are ready to carve. Be sure to saw at a 90° angle, holding the cutting utensil like a pencil and saw steadily with a continuous motion. Clean out the seeds and strings with an ice scream scooper, scraping the inner pulp away from the area you plan to carve until the pumpkin wall is approximately 1" thick.

After your pumpkin has been carved, put petroleum jelly on the cut edges of the pumpkin. This will prevent your jack-o'-lantern from shriveling. As your pumpkin ages, you can revive your pumpkin with a soak in cold water for up to 8 hours followed by more petroleum jelly on the carvings to preserve your creation.

For the grand finale, light your jack-o'-lantern using a candle or flameless tea light. Make a chimney by cutting a hole on the upper, back part of the pumpkin, this will allow any heat to escape.

For something fun, sprinkle a little cinnamon on the inside of the lid of your pumpkin.

When you light the candle, your pumpkin will fill the room with a sweet pumpkin pie scent.

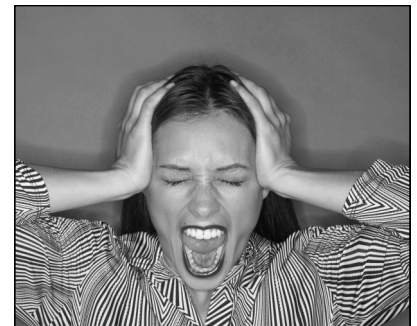
